This week Miss Melissa will be reading the Easter Story from the Spark children's Bible, there are pages to color telling the Easter story and a craft to make paper Easter lilies.

How to make Paper Easter Lilies:

You Will Need:

- Paper – any color will do but Easter lilies are white
- Drinking straws
- Toilet paper roll
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape

How To:

1. Trace your hand on paper using a pencil or a marker. Outline all the five fingers along with the palm.
2. Cut the hand-print and roll it vertically – it should look like a funnel.
3. Curl down the fingers of each roll to make the flower bloom.
4. Take a straw and attach one end of it to the end of the flower roll with tape
5. Your handprint Easter Lilly is ready. Make three or more for a beautiful bunch.
6. Make a vase out of a cardboard toilet paper roll and decorate it if you want with paint, markers or crayons.
